

# Eco-Cycle Delivery Bags

## Made with at least 20% POST-CONSUMER recycled plastics

Eco-Cycle bags are the most environmentally responsible newspaper bags available because they keep plastic in the recycling loop and out of the landfill. They are made using **post-consumer** recycled materials AND they are recyclable into other products.

**Eco-Cycle bags are the only bags on the market made with post-consumer recycled materials.** Post-consumer recycled material comes from plastic that has been used and recycled by consumers. If the plastic had not been recycled, it would have gone into a landfill.

Re-grind materials also go into Eco-Cycle bags. Re-grind comes from waste that is generated in the manufacturing process. It is good environmental practice to use re-grind materials but it does not divert or prevent waste from going to a landfill.

ASTM International's definitions of recycling terminology are printed on the other side.

**Only Eco-Cycle bags meet the ASTM definition and requirements for post-consumer plastics materials.** If another bag manufacturer claims their bags contain recycled materials as ASTM defines them, ask for proof and certification.



Eco-Cycle bags are also recyclable and used to make outdoor decking, construction items, railroad ties and other bags. They are accepted at thousands of retail locations across the country that have plastic grocery bag collection bins. Bags that are thrown away go to the landfill where, according to the Federal Trade Commission, materials degrade very slowly, if at all.

Eco-Cycle bags come printed with a message encouraging subscribers to recycle them.
